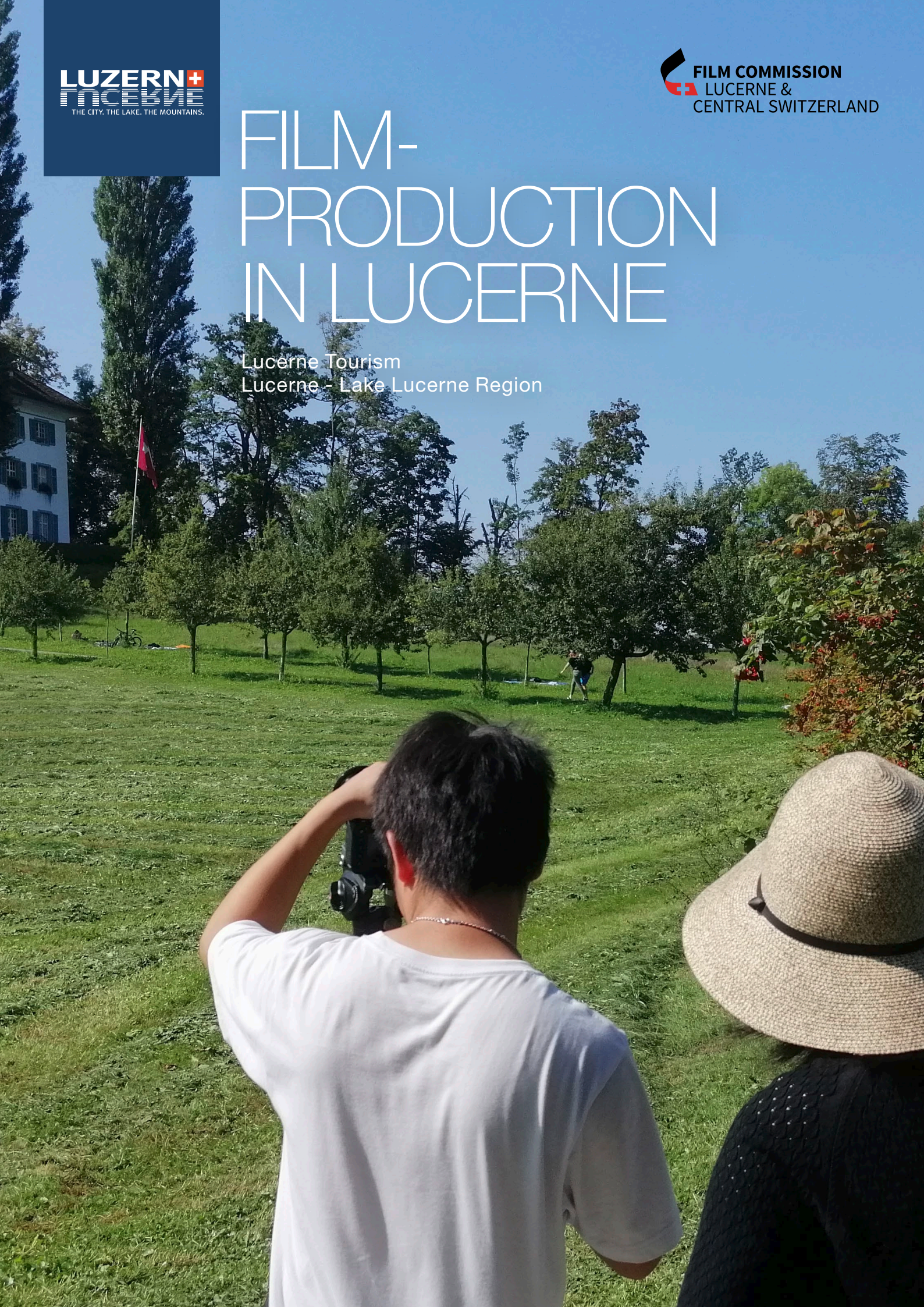

Filming in the city of Lucerne

Being one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland, Lucerne is perfectly suited as a scenery for film and video productions of all kinds. For a successful filming process, a few important points must be observed:

Generally, permission must be obtained from the City of Lucerne for filming in public spaces. Filming on private property is only permitted with the consent of the owner. Filming on bridges is not permitted for safety reasons.

In the city of Lucerne and the Lucerne lake basin, the use of a drone is not possible without a permit (see below). There is a zone with restricted air traffic above Lake Lucerne. Permits must be obtained by the drone pilot himself from the respective authority.

Operation of drones

The EU drone regulation applies in Switzerland from 1 January 2023. It specifies three different categories for the operation of drones: open, specific and certified. For operation in the open category:

- Mandatory registration via UAS.gate
- Training with examination as specified in the sub-category (A1, A2, A3). No training is required to fly a drone that weighs less than 250g.
- Minimum age for drone pilots of 12
- Minimum distance from uninvolved persons as specified in the sub-category.
- Maximum flight altitude of 120m above ground level.
- Drones must bear a CE marking and a class identification label. The transitional provisions apply to drones without a class identification label.

For the use of drones in the special category and the category requiring approval, the relevant authorities must be contacted.

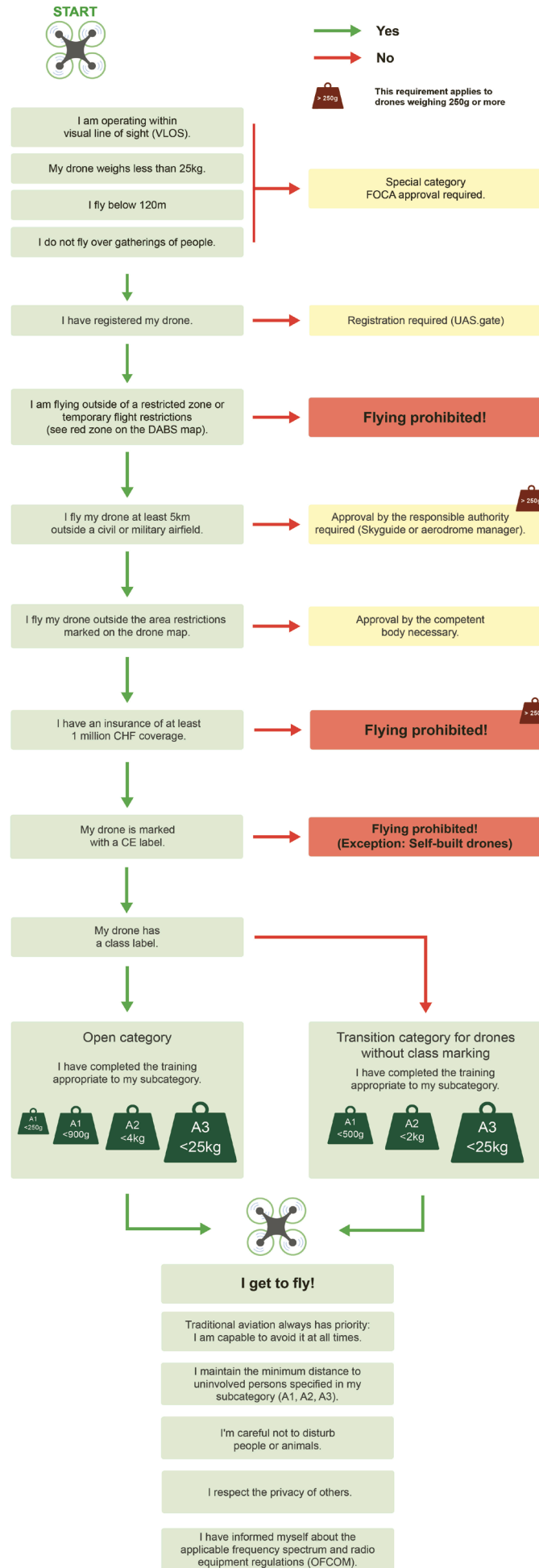
For drone flights over the lake or any water body in the Canton of Lucerne, a permit must additionally be obtained from the Lucerne Water Police (by telephone).



The interactive RPAS map (RPAS Remotely Piloted Aircraft System) published by FOCA shows those locations where restrictions and bans apply.

The FOCA drone guide (see next page) provides an overview of the applicable rules (green boxes) and information about the scenarios in which drone flight is subject to an authorisation (yellow boxes).
